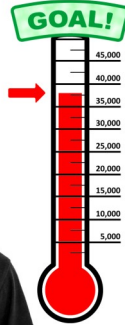

Thank you to everyone for your generous donations! We could not continue to be a blessing to Livingston County without your support. You will be receiving your 2019 donations summary in the mail next week.

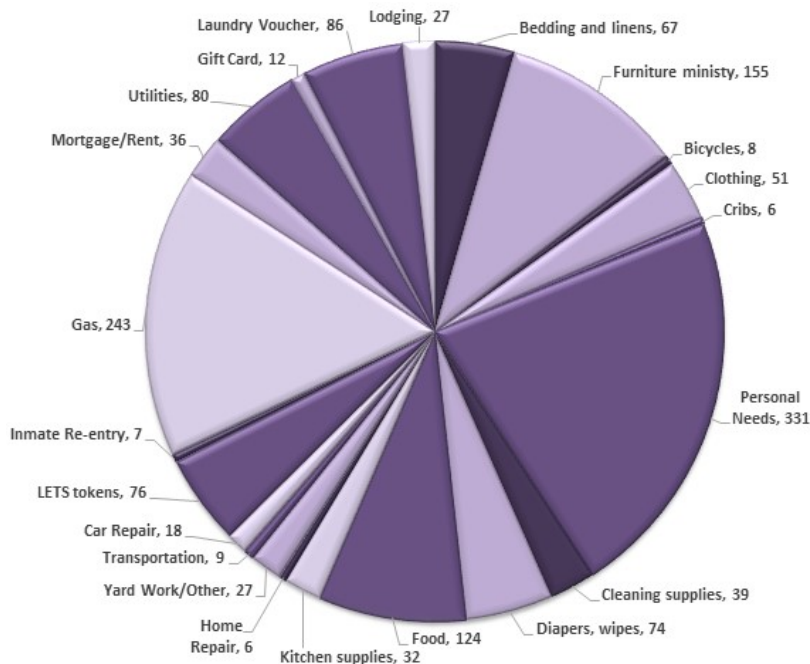
Have you noticed that stress is all around? Start decreasing your stress by joining our 4-part stress management series offered through our New Creation Ministry.
