# Message From The Director

Greetings on this new Spring season,

As it reads in Ecclesiastes 3: 1-2: "There is an appointed time for everything, and a time for every affair under the heavens. A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to uproot the plant."

It has been my great pleasure and honor to serve as the Executive Director of Love INC of the Greater Livingston Area, Love in the Name of Christ, since 2006. It is now time for me to "uproot." I have announced my retirement to the Love INC Board, effective the end of 2019. My new phase in life will be spending more time with my husband of 48 years, (we met in high school!) who retired before me, and to allow us both to travel, and most importantly, to be with our precious grandchildren and sons who live in different states.

Our affiliate has witnessed the beauty of God's immeasurable strength as we grew from 7 Partner Churches, to 62. We began with 2 service ministries, initially at 1st Presbyterian Church of Brighton with Personal Needs, and then the Furniture Ministry from Cornerstone EPC of Brighton. As the needs were identified, the churches grew the ministries, now with 6 churches providing Personal Needs, and 9 churches providing Gas Vouchers, and many more. Through Love INC, the Partner Churches are serving hundreds of Livingston County residents with new cribs, diapers, bikes, laundry vouchers, clothes, food, beds, assistance with rent, lodging, and utility bills.

This Love INC affiliate mobilized the churches, taking the lead role of forming the Severe Weather Network, serving and providing overnight lodging for county residents experiencing homelessness.

In 2017 God called us to launch 2 new initiatives: the opening of the Love INC Resale Store and transformational ministry, "New Creation", which provides hope, growth, and mentoring to participants. Through God's will, this ministry will continually expand while we witness the depth of God's love as lives are impacted daily to individuals seeking change.

Change is a challenge for all involved. Some embrace it; others ignore it; many avoid it due to the disruption it may cause.

With our "change," the Love INC Board has begun a search for my replacement, allowing ample time to hire, introduce, and transition from my leadership to another's. I am committed to make this a seamless transition as our affiliate enters a period of continued growth and prosperity. I will remain in the area to participate less actively in this process.

I ask for your prayers, support, and understanding as we enter this new phase of our life. God has a plan for us all, and I embrace His journey for me in the days and months ahead. "Many are the plans in a man's heart, but it is the decision of the Lord that endures." Proverbs 20: 21.

The Core Class is a weekly class offered Wednesdays during the day at the Love INC office to the community of Livingston County. We started out as a small group but God is adding to our numbers weekly as others have been invited to join the class. From the start God has enabled this study to be a blessing for all. Additionally, new Bibles and journals have been donated for all of the participants.

Throughout this study we have shared tears, laughter, community, commitment and friendship as we have grown in the promises from God's Word. That is how transformation happens – one day at a time. As we are nearing the end of this eight-week class, it is bittersweet, but I am excited about the new connections that were made and look forward for God to move in the next class series.
